

**AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT
 BETWEEN
 THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE OF THE
 UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
 AND
 THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE OF GEORGIA
 CONCERNING COOPERATION IN THE AREA OF
 PREVENTION OF PROLIFERATION OF TECHNOLOGY, PATHOGENS
 AND EXPERTISE RELATED TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF
 BIOLOGICAL WEAPONS**

Pursuant to Article VII of the Agreement between the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Ministry of Defense of Georgia Concerning Cooperation in the Area of Prevention of Proliferation of Technology, Pathogens and Expertise Related to the Development of Biological Weapons, dated December 30, 2002, as amended March 23, 2004 and August 30, 2004, hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement", the Department of Defense of the United States of America and the Ministry of Defense of Georgia hereby agree to amend:

- 1) Article III, Paragraph 1 by replacing the words "thirty (30) million" with the words "sixty (60) million".
- 2) Article III, paragraph 2 by inserting the words "infrastructure elimination at Tabakhmela and" between "but is not limited to", and "assistance for improving biological material protection, control and accountability".

This Amendment shall enter into force upon the date on which the Parties exchange written notifications confirming the completion by each Party of all applicable procedures required for the entry into force of the Amendment, and shall remain in force for the duration of the Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, being duly authorized by their respective governments, have signed this Amendment.
