The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Honduras and, referring to the Embassy's note number 53 of May 9, 1974, together with the Ministry's note number 829-SAC of May 15, 1975, which constitute an Agreement concerning payment to the United States of net proceeds from the sale or disposal of defense articles furnished on a grant basis, proposes that the Agreement be amended.

The Agreement would be amended by replacing "under the military assistance program of", with "on a grant basis from" in the second paragraph.

If this proposal is acceptable to Honduras, the Embassy of the United States proposes that this note and the Ministry's affirmative note in reply shall constitute an agreement between the two Governments which shall enter into force on the date of the Ministry's reply.

The Embassy of the United States of America avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the host government the assurances of its highest consideration.
