MONTREAL, CANADA**ARTICLE I—ASSIGNMENT AND AMENDMENT**

A. In recognition of the transfer of aviation security functions from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) of the Department of Transportation of the United States of America to the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) of the Department of Homeland Security of the United States of America, the FAA and International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) agree that the rights and obligations of the FAA under Memorandum of Cooperation AIA/CA-46, as amended ("the MOC"), shall be assigned to the TSA.

B. In support of the foregoing assignment, the FAA and ICAO agree to the following amendments to the MOC pursuant to Article VI of the MOC:

1. The title of the MOC shall be amended by substituting "Department of Homeland Security" and "Transportation Security Administration" in place of "Department of Transportation" and "Federal Aviation Administration", respectively.
2. The first paragraph of the preamble to the MOC shall be amended by substituting "Department of Homeland Security, Transportation Security Administration" and "TSA" in place of "Federal Aviation Administration" and "FAA", respectively.
3. The second paragraph of the preamble shall be deleted.
4. The last paragraph of the preamble to the MOC and Articles I-IX of the MOC shall be amended by substituting "TSA" in place of "FAA" wherever the latter term appears.
5. The second paragraph of Article IV (Funding) of the MOC shall be amended by replacing the FAA billing address with the following TSA address:

6. Article V (Liaison) of the MOC shall be amended by replacing "Manager, Administrative Systems & Overseas Support Staff, API-19, Office of the Associate Administrator for Policy, Planning, and International Aviation" with "Chief of Staff, International Affairs."

ARTICLE II—EFFECTIVE DATE

This Amendment shall become effective upon signature of both parties. All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in effect.


ARTICLE III—AUTHORITY
